If you have a smart phone and/or a computer this program should be right on point. ask your friends who have smart phones to come too.

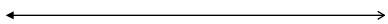

**February Presentation****Review by Ron Dack**

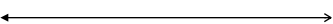
Ron Rogers did a great job. He was easy to hear, clear, Concise, and knowledgeable.
